


## **ABOUT US**

## INTRODUCTION

Bloggers established the Lusaka Internet Meet-Up in 2019. This is an in-country, annual, multistakeholder signature event that convenes different groups who are interested in the area of digitalisation in Zambia. The event is meant to promote an affordable, free, open, resilient, and inclusive internet for all in line with global best practices. The stakeholders include civil society, academia, regulators, media, law enforcement, lawyers, policymakers, legislators, service providers, technologists, government agencies and ministries etc to share experiences, policy directions, and legislative processes and to network on issues of digitalization. The Lusaka Internet Meet-Up is also open for participation from interested groups and partners from abroad who are keen on supporting the in-country event.

The Lusaka Internet Meet-Up also looks at how various stakeholders can exchange ideas, knowledge and establish collaborations on how we all can amalgamate our efforts and make recommendations on how to harness the digital transformation in terms of law and policy processes, regulations, education and awareness etc. The Lusaka Internet Meet-up is an opportunity to advance conversations and collaborations regarding the challenges and opportunities of the digital transformation that is rapidly taking place in Zambia.
